Hazard	Risk	Control Measures	Risk Level
Toileting	Slips, falls or minor injury	Children use the toilet independently where appropriate. Staff members supervise from outside the toilet and remain nearby to provide assistance if required.	Low
Hygiene	Spread of bacteria and viruses	Children wash their hands with soap and warm water. Paper towels are provided for drying hands.	Low
Cleaning of Toilets	Cross-contamination	Toilets are cleaned regularly as required using appropriate cleaning products.	Low
Toilet Accidents	Exposure to bodily fluids	Any accidents are dealt with immediately. Contaminated areas are cleaned and disinfected. Staff wear disposable gloves when cleaning bodily fluids.	Low
Cleaning Products	Access to hazardous substances	Cleaning products are stored securely and out of children's reach at all times.	Low
Privacy & Safeguarding	Maintaining dignity	Children are encouraged to manage toileting independently. Staff remain outside the toilet unless assistance is required.	Low
Communication with Parents	Failure to share concerns	Parents are informed of any toileting accidents or concerns on the same day.	Low
