Statement of Commitment

Procedures

Resources and activities will reflect diverse cultures, family structures and backgrounds. Any concerns relating to discrimination, bullying or exclusion will be addressed promptly. Reasonable adjustments will be made to support children with additional needs. We will work closely with families to ensure individual needs are understood and met.

Monitoring

This policy will be reviewed annually and updated in line with legislation and best practice guidance.

Responsibilities

All staff, volunteers and visitors are expected to follow this policy. Concerns, incidents and breaches must be reported promptly and recorded appropriately. Training will be provided where necessary and policies will be reviewed annually to ensure continued compliance with legislation and best practice.
